Journalism and Media Studies (4years)	At least two relevant Arts subjects at ‘A’ level . One of the subjects must be Literature in English or Shona/ Ndebele.	Reporters on public and private newspapers, reporters on public broadcast television and radio stations, video and film editors, public relations officers, media rights policy archivists, media policy makers and information officers.
Library and Information Science (4years)	Two relevant subjects at ‘A’ level.  <b>OR</b> <b>Special Entry:</b> Academic qualifications (other than degree, eg diploma, Higher National Diploma) acceptable to NUST, obtained from a University or an Institution of a similar status.	Librarian, bibliographer, teaching/lecturing, information management professional/expert, information officer, Public relations officer, Knowledge manager, Research officer, Database Administrator, Webmaster.
